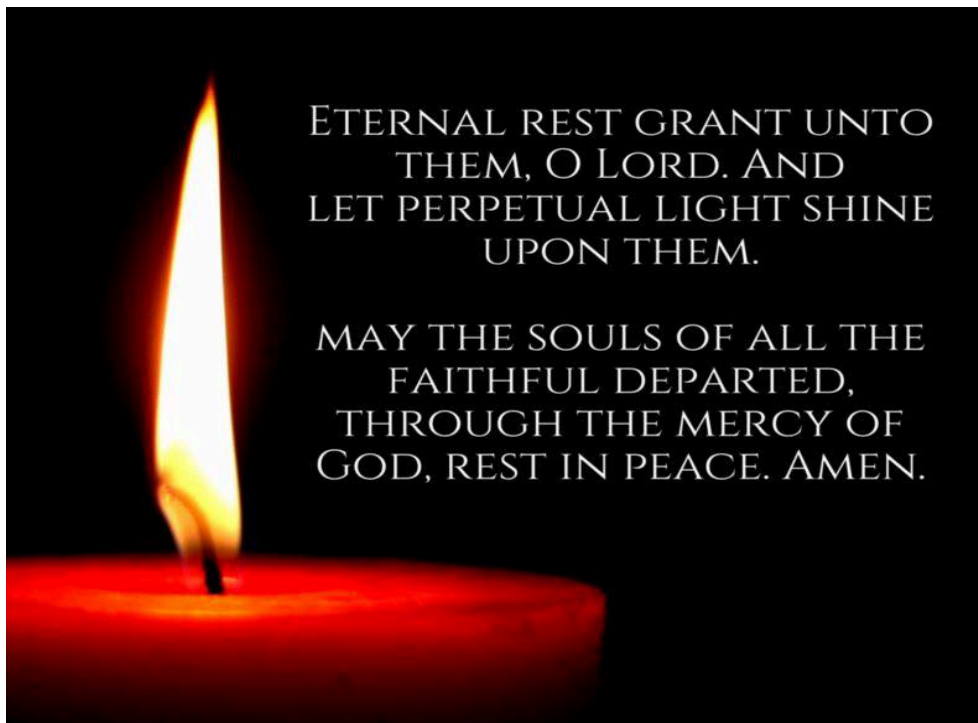

One way to do this is to have a Mass said, whether it is for a friend or family member who is going through a rough time, to celebrate a special occasion in someone's life, or to request a Mass intention for someone who has passed away.

If you wish to have a Mass offered in memory of or in honor of a loved one, or for another intention, you can either stop in the parish office during business hours or you can complete this form and put it, along with the stipend of \$15 per Mass, in the collection. If you would like to have a Mass card to send out, you will need to stop in to the office to complete your request.
