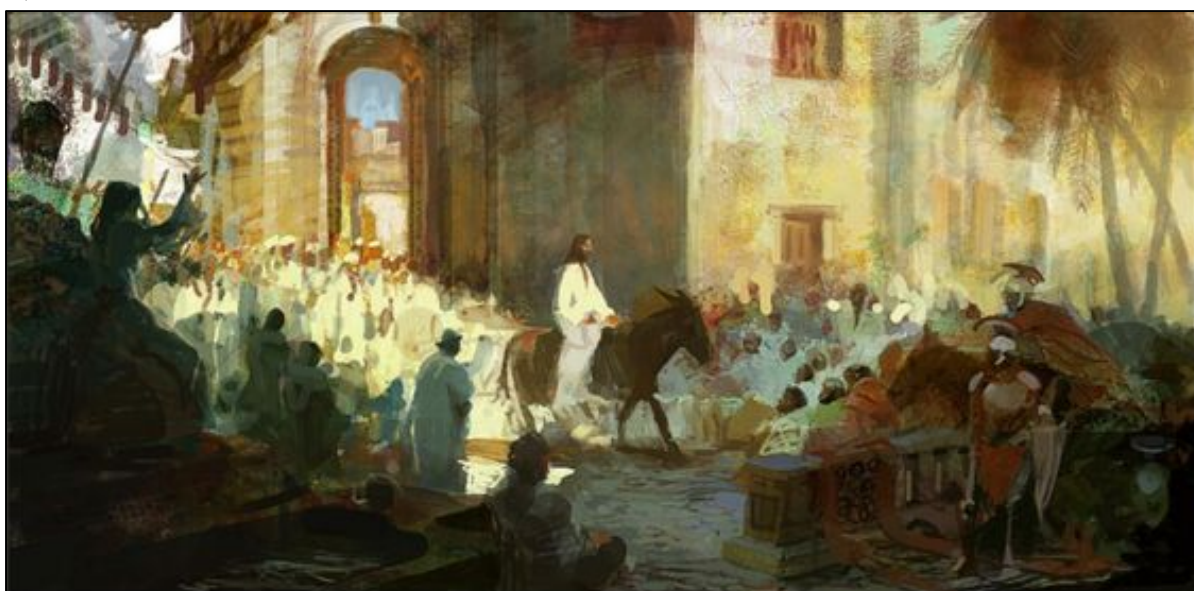

BLESSING OF THE FOOD

On Saturday at 1:00pm, there will be a blessing of the Easter food at our church in Lakewood. In this Eastern European tradition, baskets containing a sampling of Easter foods are brought to church to be blessed on Holy Saturday. The basket is traditionally lined with a white linen or lace napkin and might contain some of the following foods: hard-boiled eggs, which symbolize life and Christ's resurrection; lamb, representing Christ as the Lamb of God; salt, which represents purification; horseradish, symbolic of the bitter sacrifice of Christ; and ham, which is a symbol of great joy and abundance. Sometimes a white candle is also put into the basket to represent Christ as the Light of the World.

Please join us for this meaningful blessing of the food that will be shared at Easter dinner.

DIVINE MERCY SUNDAY

The Divine Mercy Novena begins on Good Friday and concludes on Divine Mercy Sunday, which is one week after Easter. The message of the Divine Mercy is that God loves us no matter how great our sins. Pamphlets with the Divine Mercy Novena and Chaplet are available in the vestibule of the church. Please take one to pray the Divine Mercy Novena at home.

Also, please plan to join us in Lakewood on Divine Mercy Sunday, April 23, at 3:00pm for a special devotion to the Divine Mercy followed by a short reception.
