### CORPUS CHRISTI

This Sunday marks the feast of Corpus Christi, also known as the feast of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, a day of celebration of Christ's Real Presence in the Eucharist.

The procession on the feast of Corpus Christi is one time when our Lord in the Blessed Sacrament is exposed not just to faithful Catholics but to all the world. This is a time when Catholics can show their love for Christ in the Real Presence by honoring Him in a very public way. It is also a wonderful way in which we can show our love for our neighbors by bringing Our Lord and Savior closer to them. So many conversions are a result of Eucharistic Adoration experienced from inside the Church building. How many more there would be if we could reach those who only drive by the church in worldly pursuits?

Please join us for our parish procession after the Sunday 10:00am Mass this weekend in Lakewood. Everyone is invited to give witness to the presence of God in the Eucharist and in our lives.
