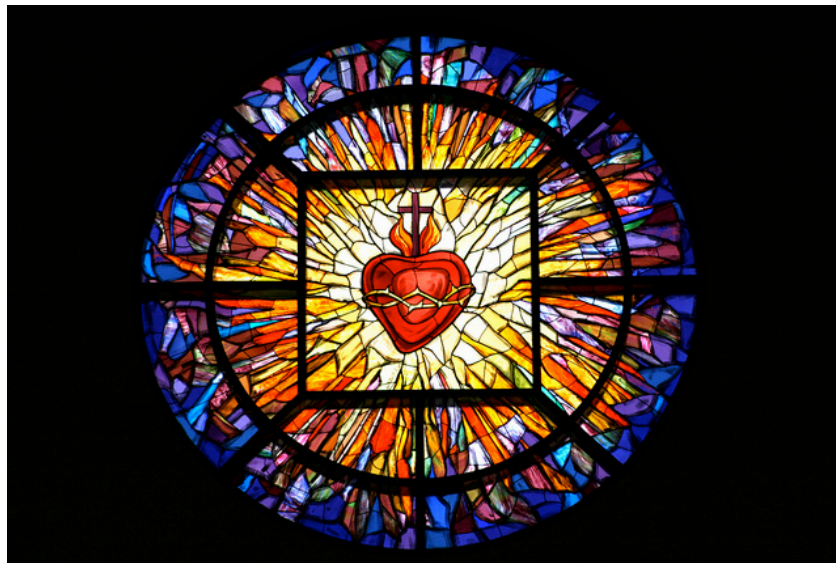

**CATHOLIC CALISTHENICS**

Have you ever wondered why Catholics sit, stand, and kneel during Mass? It's because each posture helps us get into a different mindset.

Sitting is the posture of learning. That's why we sit during the readings and the homily.

Standing is the posture of reverence and respect. Ever notice how people stand when a judge or dignitary enters the room? How much more, then, should we be in reverence when the priest processes in, when we listen to the Gospel, or join in the Prayer of the Faithful?

And kneeling is the posture of worship and humility. This is why we kneel during the Eucharistic prayer and after receiving Communion.

At a typical Mass, you'll sit four times, stand seven, and kneel three. As Catholics, we don't just worship with our hearts and minds, we put our whole bodies into it!
