PARKING IN LAKEWOOD – PLEASE READ!

After a recent inspection by the Fire Marshall, we were made aware of some parking issues. As a result, we are asking all parishioners to **refrain from parking along the side of the building** running from the front walk past the Parish Center and back to the pavilion, as this is a fire lane. There is **also no parking adjacent to the grass area in the front of the church**, as this restricts the flow of traffic in front of the new narthex stairs, which is also a fire lane. This area approaching and departing from the front steps must be clear at all times for emergency vehicles. Recently a medical incident occurred during Mass and the ambulance was unable to pull up in front of the entrance because there were vehicles parked along the grass area.

For those who need handicapped parking, there are handicapped parking spots in the parking lot at the beginning of the row closest to Fairmount Avenue, as well as in front of the rectory.

We will be repainting the parking lot in the spring to indicate the required changes and, in the meantime, appreciate your cooperation in bringing us into compliance and helping to ensure the safety of all.
