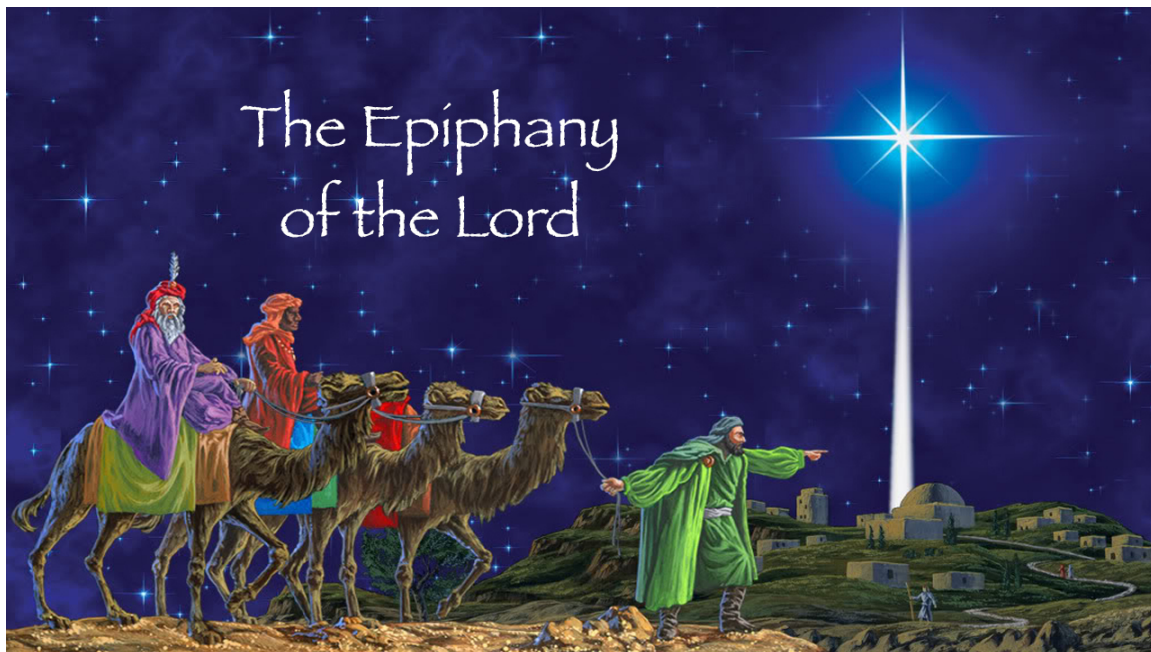

THE EPIPHANY OF THE LORD

Epiphany is the day on which we celebrate Christ revealing himself in the form of a newborn babe to the Three Wise Men, who traveled from their countries to pay tribute to the Son of God.

Tradition describes three Wise Men, named Melchior, Caspar and Balthazar, who were told of Christ's birth and set off, following the Star of Bethlehem, to meet the baby Jesus. Each king brought with him gifts of gold, frankincense and myrrh to represent Jesus' elevated position, divine birth and mortality, respectively.

In the Catholic Church, the Epiphany is celebrated on the Sunday closest to January 6.
