CATHOLIC CEMETERY MOMENT

A Catholic cemetery is indeed a special and holy place. It is sacred because it is a place where prayer and liturgy are celebrated. It serves as a symbol of the extended community of believers, a community unbroken by death. The Catholic cemetery, then, is sacred, not only because of a blessing or consecration, but also by the sacred function that it performs on behalf of the entire Christian community.



THE MONTH OF THE HOLY ROSARY

As you pray the rosary, if you have time, pause between decades for a personal prayer. On the other hand, if you are really busy, you can divide up the rosary – one decade before breakfast, one while driving to work, and so on.

This week we highlight the joyful mysteries of the rosary, which are traditionally prayed on Monday and Saturday.

The Annunciation – The Angel Gabriel tells Mary that she is to be the Mother of God. (Humility)

The Visitation – The Blessed Virgin pays a visit to her cousin Elizabeth. (Charity)

The Nativity – The Infant Jesus is born in a stable in Bethlehem. (Poverty)

The Presentation – The Blessed Virgin presents the Child Jesus to Simeon in the temple. (Obedience)

The Finding in the Temple – Jesus is lost for three days, and the Blessed Mother finds Him in the Temple. (Piety)
