PRAYING THE ROSARY



In addition to meditating on the mysteries, whether they be the joyous, glorious, sorrowful, or luminous mysteries, there are certain prayers that we say as part of the Rosary.

We begin by making the sign of the cross. Then we say the Apostles' Creed, one Our Father, three Hail Mary's, and one Glory to the Father on the small chain. Then we recall the first mystery, say one Our Father, ten Hail Mary's, one Glory to the Father, and the Fatima prayer (*Oh, my Jesus, forgive us our sins, save us from the fires of Hell and lead all souls to Heaven, especially those in most need of Thy mercy*). This completes one decade. All the other decades are said in the same manner with a different mystery meditated upon during each decade. The mysteries of the rosary are scenes from the life of Jesus and Mary. By meditating on these truths, we come to a better understanding of our religion: the Incarnation of the Lord, the Redemption, and the Christian life – present and future.

At the end of the rosary, the prayer Hail, Holy Queen may be recited.

SCAM ALERT!

Recently, one of our local churches was the subject of a scam. The phone number of the parish office was cloned. Using that number, the perpetrator texted some members of the parish claiming to be the pastor and saying that he was working with a family in need and asking the parishioners to buy gift cards to send to him. Since the church's phone number showed up in the text, at least one person believed it and purchased a gift card.

Please know that neither Fr. Piotr nor Deacon Dan would ever text you asking for money, gift cards, or anything of that nature.
