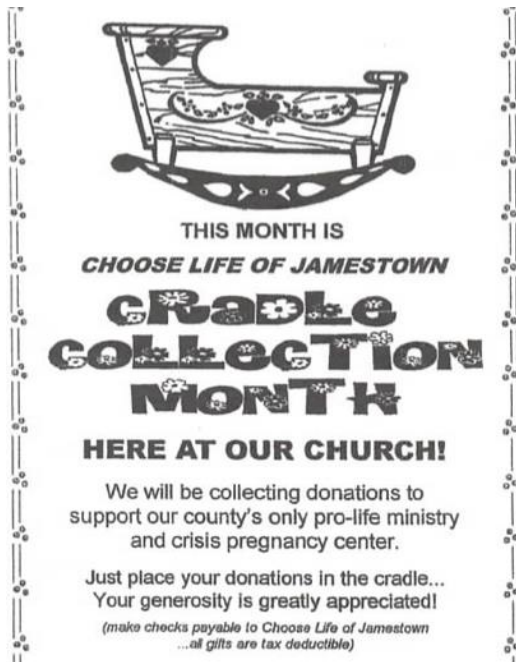

**THE MONTH OF THE HOLY ROSARY**

Keep your rosary handy! You are more likely to say the rosary if you don’t have to search for it first. Keep it clean and treat it with respect. It is not ordinarily a necklace or a toy. A blessed rosary is a sacramental and praying it carries an indulgence.

This week we will focus on the sorrowful mysteries of the rosary, which are traditionally prayed on Tuesday and Friday.

**The Agony in the Garden** – On the eve of His passion and death, Jesus prays in the Garden of Olives. (Contrition)

**The Scourging at the Pillar** – Jesus is tied to a pillar and cruelly beaten with whips. (Purity)

**The Crowning with Thorns** – A crown of thorns is placed upon Jesus’ head. (Courage)

**The Carrying of the Cross** – Jesus is made to carry His cross to Calvary. (Patience)

**The Crucifixion** – Jesus is nailed to the cross and dies for our sins. (Self-denial)
