THE MONTH OF THE HOLY ROSARY

October is set aside by the Church as the month of the Holy Rosary. The mysteries of the rosary are designed to help focus our prayer on the life, ministry, and Passion of Our Lord. Meditating on the life of Christ with the prayers of the rosary – through the intercession of the Blessed Mother – is a way to grow in faith and deepen your relationship with Christ. Each week during October, one set of the mysteries of the rosary will be highlighted. This week, the focus will be on the glorious mysteries, which are traditionally prayed on Sunday and Wednesday.

The Resurrection – Jesus rises from the dead, three days after His death. (Faith)

The Ascension – Forty days after His death, Jesus ascends into heaven. (Hope)

The Descent of the Holy Spirit – Ten days after the ascension, the Holy Spirit comes to the apostles and the Blessed Mother in the form of fiery tongues. (Love)

The Assumption – The Blessed Virgin dies and is assumed into heaven. (Eternal Happiness)

The Crowning of the Blessed Virgin – The Blessed Virgin is crowned Queen of Heaven and Earth by Jesus, her son. (Devotion to Mary)
