FROM THE PASTOR

Luke 9:51-62

“The Son of Man

In today’s Gospel Jesus is referred to by the title of “the Son of Man”. “The Son of Man” is one of the expressions used in the Old Testament to refer to the Messiah. It first appeared in Daniel 7:14 and was used in Jewish writings during the time of Jesus. Until our Lord began to preach, it had not been understood in all its depth. The title “The Son of Man” did not fit very well with Jewish hopes of an earthly Messiah: This is why it was Jesus’ favorite way of indicating He was the Messiah - thereby avoiding any tendency to encourage Jewish nationalism. After the Resurrection the Apostles finally realized that “the Son of Man” meant nothing less than “the Son of God”. The Word became flesh to make us “partakers of the divine nature”. “For this is why the Word became man, and the Son of God became the son of man; so that man...might become a son of God.
