Deuteronomy 30:10-14 - 15th Sunday "The Ten Commandments"

The Ten Commandments, referred to in today's first reading, have always had a central place in the moral teaching of the Church. In this Letter to the Romans, St. Paul says those who have no heard of the Ten Commandments still know what is right wrong because what the law requires is written on their hearts" (Rom 2:15). This knowledge of what is right and wrong, somehow written on our hearts, is also known as the natural moral law. The expression "natural law" is used by the Church to emphasize that the moral principles taught by Christ and the Church are for all people, for all times and places, for all cultures and situations. They are fundamentally immutable; they oblige always and everywhere; they have no exceptions. (CCC 2072). When asked what one must do to have eternal life Jesus responded: "If you wish to enter into life, keep the commandments"
