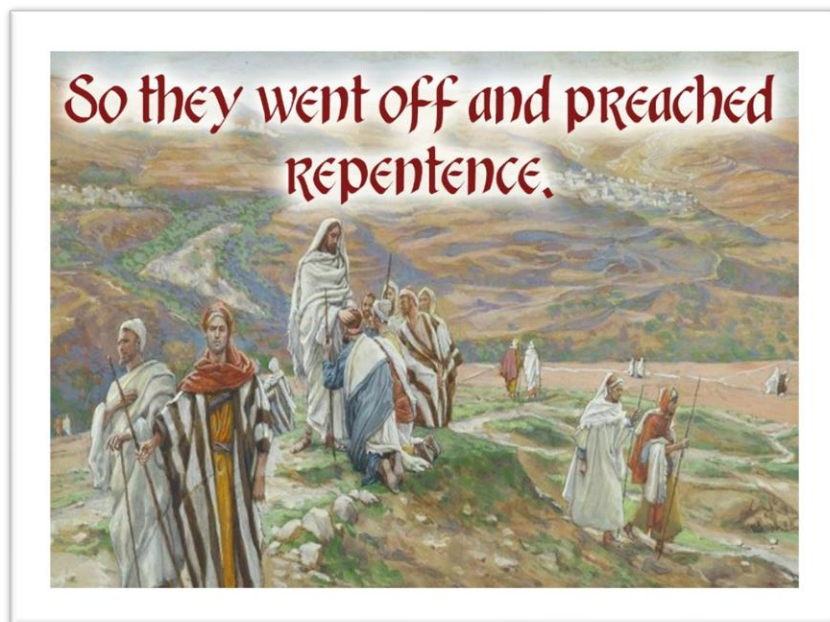

**FROM OUR PASTOR**

**Mark 6:7-13-15<sup>th</sup> Sunday in Ordinary Time**

**“Sacrament of the Sick and Dying.”**

A sacrament is an outward sign, instituted by Christ to give grace. In today's Gospel Mark writes, “And they cast out many devils and anointed with oil many that were sick and healed them.” (V)13). While this passage indicates a reference to the Sacrament of the Sick and Dying the definitive text for this sacrament is found in James 5:14-15: “Is anyone among you sick...summon the priests...pray over him...anoint him...with oil in the name of the Lord...and the prayer of faith will save the sick person...if he has committed any sins, he will be forgiven.” Here we see an outward sign (anointing with oil), instituted by Christ (“in the name of the Lord”) ...and the granting of grace (remission of sin). This sacrament is a holy gift of God. We should pray that all our loved ones, and ourselves, are fortunate enough to receive this sacrament at the hour of death.
