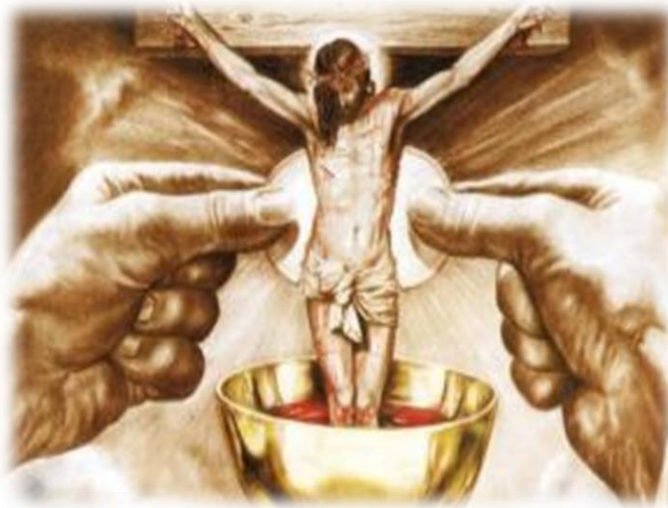

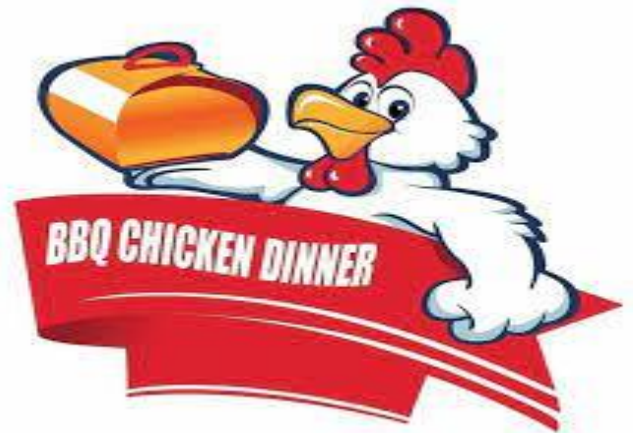
FROM OUR PASTOR

John6:45-51 – 19th Sunday in Ordinary Time

Week 2 of the “Bread of Life Discourse” finds the Jews confused because Jesus said He is the “Bread that came down from heaven” (v41). Jesus requires belief for eternal life (v47) as He repeats His solemn declaration for those doubters in the crowd: “I am the bread of life” (v48). Christ’s words are too descriptive to be taken symbolically. If Jesus were not truly present under the species of bread and wine this discourse would make sense. If there were any doubts the last words of today’s Gospel should have erased them: “...the bread which I shall give for the life of the world is my flesh” (v51). “The eucharist is the source and summit of the Christian life” (CCC1324). As Catholics we are obliged to believe that the bread and wine are transformed into the actual body and blood of Jesus Christ at Mass. Why? Simple, because Jesus said so!
