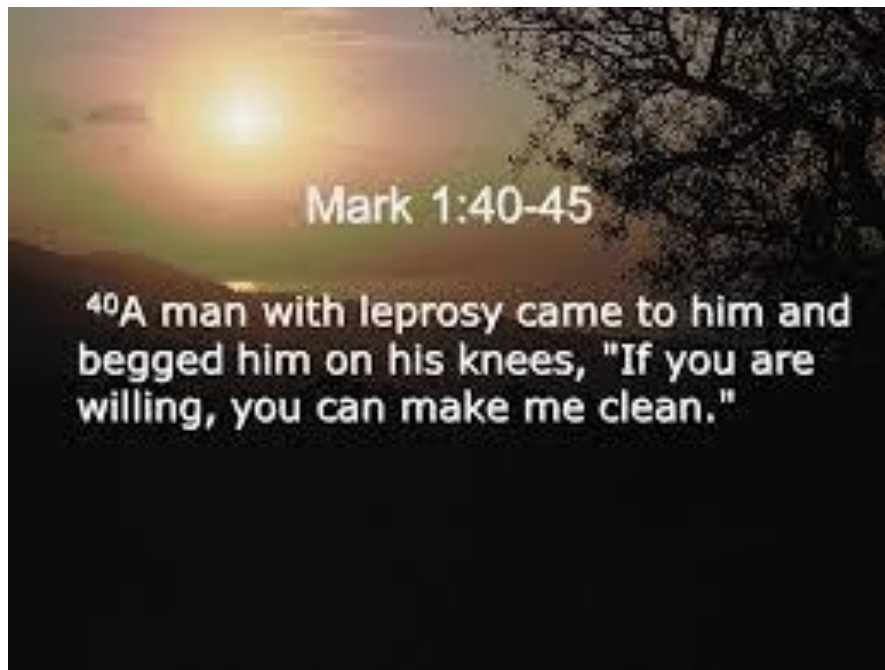

**THINGS TO REMEMBER**

With Lent beginning on Wednesday, here are some things all Catholics should keep in mind:

**Abstinence:** Catholics who have reached their 14<sup>th</sup> birthday are bound to abstain totally from meat on Ash Wednesday, all Fridays of Lent, and Good Friday.

**Fasting:** Catholics between their 18<sup>th</sup> and 59<sup>th</sup> birthdays are also bound to observe the Law of Fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. This means to limit oneself to a single full meal and to avoid food between meals. Light sustenance may be taken on two other occasions in the course of the day.

**Easter Duty:** After they have made their First Holy Communion, all the faithful are bound by the obligation of receiving Communion at least once a year. This precept must be fulfilled during the Easter season, unless for a good reason it is fulfilled at another time during the year. This year, the Easter season runs from February 18 (First Sunday in Lent) to May 27 (Trinity Sunday).

**Reconciliation:** Catholics are bound by an obligation to confess serious sins at least once a year.

**Other Fridays of the Year:** All other Fridays of the year remain as days of penance, in prayerful remembrance of the Passion of Jesus Christ.

**PARISH CENTER DOORS**

You may be aware that the doors to our Parish Center in Lakewood can no longer be unlocked from the outside and one will not open at all. Apparently, these were a previously-used set that was donated at the time of the construction of the Parish Center. Unfortunately, it has been determined that they cannot be repaired and will have to be replaced. It is partly for unexpected expenses such as this that our Maintenance Fund was created. Please remember your Maintenance Fund envelope for next week's second collection.
