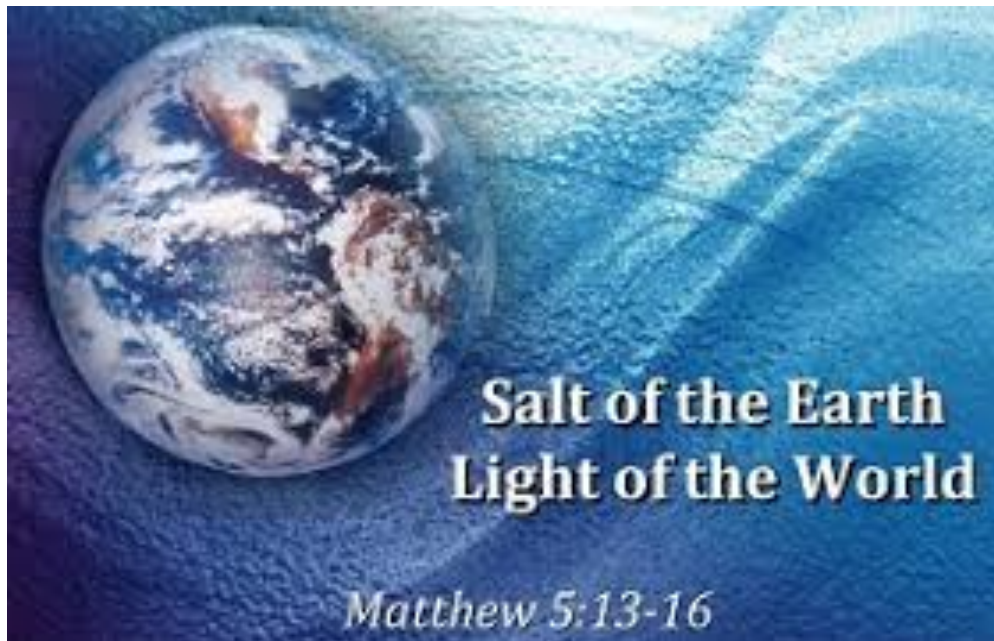

COLD AND FLU SEASON

The cold and flu season is here and, with it, come some precautions we should take to try to keep ourselves and those around us healthy.

Mass Attendance: First, please understand that, while attendance at Sunday Mass (or the Saturday Vigil Mass), is required, there are circumstances in which Catholics are excused from that obligation. Those circumstances include severe weather or suffering from a severe cold or other contagious illness. If you have a severe cold or the flu, please stay home and do not risk spreading the infection to others.

Sign of Peace: Please do not take offense if someone chooses not to shake hands with you during the Sign of Peace. An appropriate gesture for those who are concerned about spreading the flu might be to clasp your hands together and, with a smile, say "Peace be with you."

Receiving Holy Communion: The Center for Disease Control has published a report stating that sharing the cup at Holy Communion poses a very low risk of transmission of disease. However, if you are feeling sick or suspect that you might have been exposed to something contagious, please refrain from receiving Holy Communion from the cup, and receive only the Sacred Host.

Heeding Medical Advice: If you've been told by your medical advisor that you are particularly susceptible to infection or to complications due to flu in particular, please refrain from practices that might make you sick, including shaking hands, receiving Holy Communion on the tongue, and drinking the Precious Blood from the chalice.

In other words, please use your common sense to keep yourself and those around you healthy.

CATHOLIC CHARITIES

When Brian was 14, he began to act out and become physically aggressive. His mother was at a loss as to how to help her son. "I tried getting Brian a mentor, took him for counseling, talked to our priest, and nothing seemed to work. Then Father suggested Catholic Charities." Through MST, a program designed for at-risk youth, Brian and his mother found ways to manage his behavior and get on track to a more peaceful home life.
