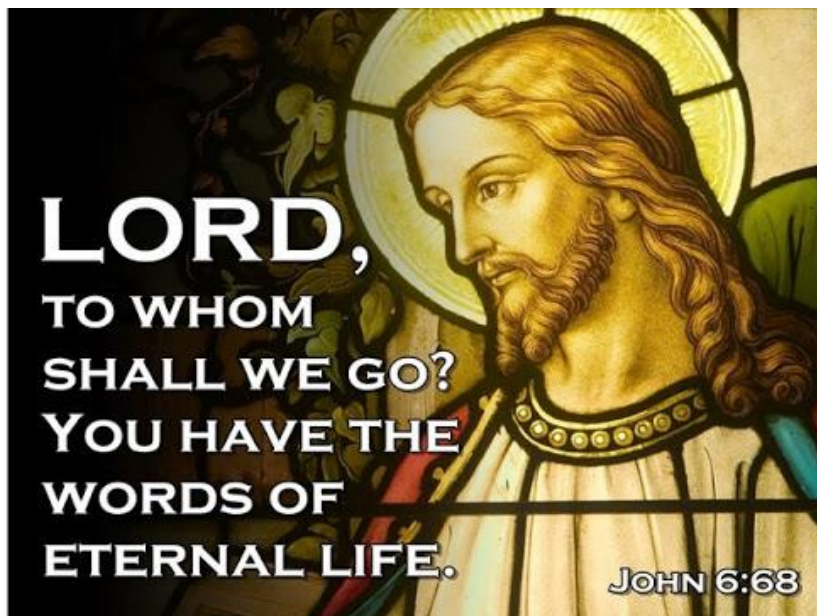

FROM OUR PASTOR

John 6:60-69-21st Sunday in Ordinary Time
As the "Bread of Life Discourse" concludes, many of Jesus' disciples who hear Him say "eat my flesh and drink my blood" are now saying "This is a hard saying: who can listen to it?" (v60). As a result, many disciples left Jesus (v66). If the disciples had interpreted Jesus' words in a symbolic sense it would not have been a 'hard saying'. No, they knew Jesus was speaking literally and they left because they did not believe! (v64). Jesus did not say, "wait, come back, I'm sorry—you misunderstand me." Nor did Jesus say the bread and wine would 'symbolize' His flesh and blood. If that is what he meant He would have used one of more than two dozen Aramaic words that meant 'represents' or 'symbolizes'. Twelve times Jesus said He was "the bread from heaven"; four time He said, "eat My flesh and drink My blood" Jesus meant exactly what He said, and he fulfilled this promise the night before He died at the Last Supper when Jesus said, "Take and eat, this is My body...this is My blood" (Mt 26:26-28)
