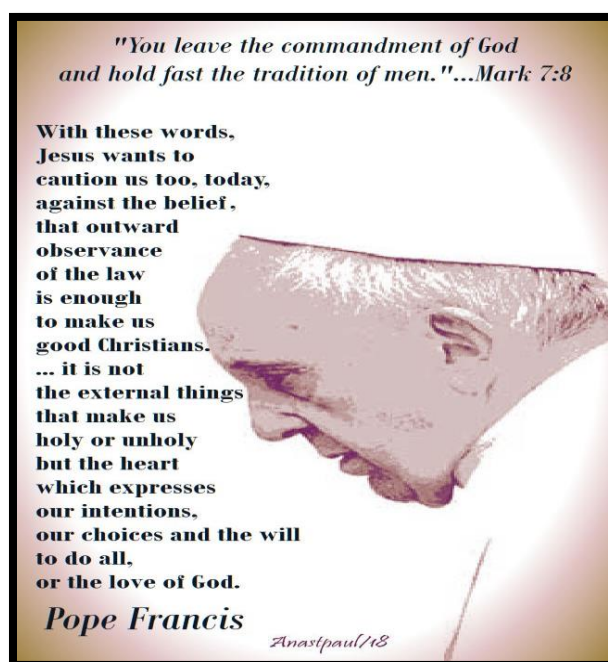

FROM OUR PASTOR

Mark 7: -8, 14-15, 21-23-22nd Sunday in Ordinary Time
"Did Jesus Condemn Tradition?"

In today's Gospel, Jesus condemns a tradition that violates the word of God. The Fourth Commandment directs people to honor and care for their parents. To avoid doing this the Pharisees declared their property and money "Corban", which means they are dedicated to God and cannot be used for parental support. Thus, Jesus condemns this "tradition of man" because it is a custom or discipline that nullifies God's commandment. But Sacred Tradition should not be confused with mere traditions of men. Sacred Traditions preserves doctrines first taught by Jesus to the Apostles who passed them down to us through the Church. Sacred Tradition is opposed by many non-Catholic Christians who believe all doctrine is in the Bible and that Tradition is not necessary. But that is not what the Bible teaches: "...stand firm and hold fast to the traditions that you were taught, either by and oral statement or by a letter of ours" (2Thess 2:15; also 1 Cor 11:2).
