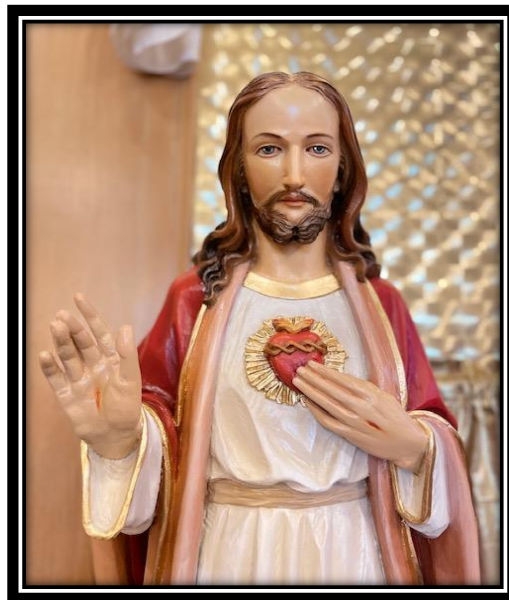

FROM OUR PASTOR

James 2:1-5-23rd Sunday in Ordinary Time
"Social Justice"

Today's second reading focuses on the need for social justice. In Gaudium et spes (29), the Fathers of Vatican II wrote: "True, all men are not alike from the point of view of varying physical power and the diversity of intellectual and moral resources. Nevertheless, with respect to the fundamental rights of the person, every type of discrimination, whether social or cultural, whether based on sex, race, color, social condition, language, religion, is to be overcome and eradicated as contrary to God's intent." Why? "Because all men, having a rational soul and being created in God's image, have the same nature and origin, and because all men, having been redeemed by Christ, enjoyed the same divine calling and destiny." Every human being is of priceless value; made in the image and likeness of God, redeemed by Christ, and called to an eternal destiny. We must protect the dignity and transcendent worth of every human being, from conception to natural death.
