FROM THE PASTOR

Mark 9:38-43,47-48-26th Sunday Ordinary Time

"Hell"

Hell is not a popular topic, but it is a reality. Jesus spoke forcefully in today's Gospel describing "hell", where the worm never dies, and the fire is never quenched "(v48) and where "...There shall be weeping and gnashing of teeth" (Mt 13:49-50). Some deny the existence of hell by rationalizing that a merciful God could never send His children to hell. But refusing to believe in hell is refusing to take God seriously. "The teaching of the Church affirms the existence of hell and its eternity" (CCC1035). God predestines no one to hell (CCC1037). Those who go to hell only do so because they choose to go; they have never asked for mercy, and they never will. To be separated from God, the source of all love and happiness, will be the greatest pain in hell. Our Lord makes it clear that condemnation to hell is the greatest of all misfortunes: "it is better for him, if that man had not been born" (Mt26:324). We should think often of hell and its reality, go to confession regularly and pray and Act of Contrition daily while always remaining in a state of grace.
