FROM THE PASTOR

Mark 10:17-30 – 28th Sunday Ordinary Time

"Eternal Life – At What Price?"

"What must I do to enter eternal life?" (v17). John Paul II had a response to this question: heed the call of Christ when you hear him saying to you: 'Follow me! Walk in my path! Stand at my side! Remain in my love!' There is a choice to be made: a choice for Christ and his way of life, and his commandment of love...If you really accept that love from Christ, it will lead you to God...Whatever you make of your life, let it be something that reflects the love of Christ...The sadness of the young man makes us reflect. We could be tempted to think that many possessions, many of the goods of this world, can bring happiness. We see instead the young man's ...many possessions had become an obstacle to accepting the call of Jesus to follow him. He was not ready to say "yes" to Jesus and "no" to self, to say "yes" to love and "no" to escape. Real love is demanding...Love demands effort and a personal commitment to the will of God. It means discipline and sacrifice, but it is also meaning joy and human fulfillment" (John Paul II, Homily of Boston Commerce)
