4. Spiritual Healing. Praying the rosary allows God to enter our hearts as we meditate throught the repetitive prayers, we can better hear God.
5. Prayer works. The power of prayer is unspeakable. It is our lifeline to God.

FROM THE PASTOR

Mark 10:35 – 45 -29th Sunday in Ordinary Time
“A Mission of Christian Service”

Our Lord’s word and example should encourage us in a genuine spirit of Christian service. Only the Son of God who came down from heaven and freely submitted Himself to humiliation can ask a person to make himself last if he wishes to be first (v44). The Church continues Christ’s mission of service to mankind as the Vatican II Fathers wrote in **Gaudium et spes.**(3): “Experienced in human affairs, the Church...seeks but a solitary goal: to carry forward the work of Christ himself under the lead of the befriending Spirit. And Christ entered this world to give witness to the truth, to rescue and not to sit in judgment, to serve and not to be served.” Our attitude should be that of our Lord: we should seek to serve God and men with a truly supernatural outlook, not expecting anything in return. The Christian who identifies with Christ takes pride in serving others. By doing so he shares in Christ’s mission and thereby attains his true dignity.
