**1 Corinthians 12:4-11 -2nd Sunday Ordinary Time**

**Gifts of the Holy Spirit**

In today's second reading St. Paul gives us a list of special gifts of the Holy Spirit, but it can be difficult to identify what each gift involves. What is clear is that the action of the Holy Spirit is enormously fruitful. The Holy Spirit is Himself the gift (Jn 14:26f), the source of all comfort and grace, proceeding from the Father and the Son. There are seven gifts known most commonly as the Gifts of the Holy Spirit: “wisdom, understanding, counsel, fortitude, knowledge, piety, and fear of the Lord” (Is 11:1-2; CCC 1831). These gifts are infused into the heart of every baptized person, every member of Christ. We need them all, for as we grow in holiness the influence of these gifts increases. By these gifts “the soul is furnished and strengthened to be able to obey God’s voice” (On the Holy Spirit, Pope Leo XIII). Take the time to study more about these gifts.

**Prayer to the Holy Spirit**

Come, Holy Spirit, fill the hearts of your faithful. And kindle in them the fire of your love. Send forth your Spirit and they shall be created. And you will renew the face of the earth.

Lord, by thy light of the Holy Spirit you have taught the hearts of your faithful. In the same Spirit help us to rejoice in your consolation. We ask this through Christ our Lord, Amen
