**GOVERNOR'S ABORTION EXPANSION PROPOSAL**

As part of his budget bill, S.7511, Governor Cuomo has included an abortion expansion proposal. This proposal would remove the current limit on abortions after 24 weeks, permit non-doctors to perform abortions, eliminate all criminal penalties for abortions, and eliminate the law that requires that a baby born alive after an abortion be given adequate medical care instead allowing these babies to die of neglect and starvation. The diocese urges people to contact Sen. Cathy Young at 664-4603 now, before the budget vote deadline of April 1, to urge her to oppose the budget bill if this proposal remains in it.
