FIFTH SUNDAY OF LENT

The fifth Sunday of Lent is historically known as "Passion Sunday" which ushers in the final two weeks of Lent, called "Passiontide." Passiontide is characterized by a heightened celebration of Lent as Easter approaches, reaching its peak during Holy Week. During this period the faithful often redouble their Lenten penances. It is also customary on this day to shroud sacred images in the churches with purple cloths. These are then unveiled in preparation for the Easter Vigil. This imagery calls to mind how Christ hid His Divinity during His Passion and death, no longer performing miracles until His Resurrection from the dead. Likewise, these images are veiled in imitation of the Lord, being unveiled with the joy of the celebration of Easter.
