**LENTEN REMINDERS**

**Abstinence:** Catholics who have reached their 14<sup>th</sup> birthday are bound to abstain totally from meat on Ash Wednesday, all Fridays of Lent, and Good Friday.

**Fasting:** Catholics between their 18<sup>th</sup> and 59<sup>th</sup> birthdays are also bound to observe the Law of Fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. This means to limit oneself to a single full meal and to avoid food between meals. Light sustenance may be taken on two other occasions in the course of the day.

**Easter Duty:** After they have made their First Holy Communion, all the faithful are bound by the obligation of receiving Communion at least once a year. This precept must be fulfilled during the Easter season, unless for a good reason it is fulfilled at another time during the year. This year, the Easter season runs from March 10 (First Sunday in Lent) to June 16 (Trinity Sunday).

**Reconciliation:** Catholics are bound by an obligation to confess serious sins at least once a year.
