FROM THE PASTOR

Hebrews 5:1-6 – 30th Sunday Ordinary Time
“The True Sacrifice of the Mass is Scriptural”

Did you know the Mass can be proved using Scripture? The Old Testament predicts Christ will offer a true sacrifice to God using the elements of bread and wine. Genesis 14:18 tells u Melchizedek, King of Salem, was a priest who offered sacrifice using bread and wine. Psalm 109 and Hebrews 5:6 predicts Christ will be a priest according to the order of Melchizedek, i.e., offering a sacrifice, under the forms of bread and wine. We must then look for some from of sacrifice, other than Calvary, for the Crucifixion was not a sacrifice under the forms of bread and wine. After foretelling the rejection of the Jewish priesthood, the Prophet Malachi predicted a new continual sacrifice that would be a clan, unbloody sacrifice, offered in every place (Mal1:10-11). The Sacrifice of Calvary took place in one place only, so we must look for a sacrifice apart from Calvary, one offered in every place under the forms of bread and wine. That Sacrifice is the Mass!

Next week is October 31st! Our youth may dress up in their Halloween Costumes or as their favorite Saint. Please be sure costumes are appropriate for church. Please have your child bring a picture of a loved one to keep in the classroom for the month of November. Classes will say a prayer every weekend.
