And again, we approach the month of November. Again, we experience the season when many of us make some reflection on the purpose of our life, and its sense. The autumn makes us to realize that like this leaf falling from a tree, some day we all will have to leave everything, and go. Sooner or later. I can say that the month of November it is the time to make an eschatological reflection. That's why we direct our thoughts toward those who are no longer with us, who proceeded us on the way to eternity. Some have already experienced the salvation. And we celebrate their feast on the First of November – The Feast of All the Saints. We honor all the saints, not only these from the liturgical calendar but also those who are not canonized so far. This year we celebrate the feast of All the Saints on Monday. I invite you to celebrate that great solemnity. This year it is not a holy day of obligation, however I hope you will come and celebrate the Solemn Holy Mass all together on Monday, November 1 at 5:30pm.

On the Second of November we will remember all of them – our loved ones, relatives, friends, priests, religious, teachers, also all our parishioners who have already gone to meet the Lord. In the back of our churches, you find special envelopes for All Souls Day. Please, write on them the names of your loved ones. We will have a special devotion in their intention. This will take place on Tuesday, November 2 at 5:30PM in the church. We will pray the Rosary for all our deceased loved ones whose names you place on the special envelopes. We also will remember them also on very special way during the whole month of November. It is our Christian responsibility to pray for the dead. This is a wonderful occasion for each one of us to express our gratitude to them, thanking them for their everyday tasks, example, and prayers. We need their prayers too.

Let us direct our appeal and thoughts to our Heavenly Father. May these prayers be filled with love and hope, which is expressed by the Psalm 122: “I rejoiced when I heard them say: let us go to the house of the Lord.”
