FROM THE PASTOR

Hebrews 9:24-28 – 32nd Sunday Ordinary Time

“Understanding the Mass”

The Catholic Church teaches that the one, all-sufficient, bloody sacrifice of Jesus at Calvary is “made present” at each Mass “in an unbloody manner.” Christ is not resacrificed at each Mass. Christ is re-presented to the Father just as Jesus presented Himself to the Father at the Last Supper when Jesus took bread, and said, “This is my body...given up (sacrificed) for you” and “This is my blood which will be shed (sacrificed) for many.” Jesus made His sacrifice of Calvary present at the Last Supper, and He commanded His apostles to do the same at each Mass (1 Cor 11:26). Jesus is eternally a priest, and a priest’s very nature is to offer sacrifice. The eternal sacrifice that Jesus offers is Himself. That is why in Rev 5:6 Jesus appears as a lamb looking as though He has been slain. Why? Because for all eternity Jesus re-presents Himself to the Father making His one-time sacrifice on Calvary present and effective for all of us forever. The Mass is a participation in this one heavenly offering.
