FROM THE PASTOR

Daniel 12:1-3 – 33rd Sunday in Ordinary Time

"Hope in the Resurrection of the Dead"

In the Old Testament death was considered to bring religious activity to a close. The dead descended into a place called Shelo, a place of obscurity over which God continue to reign, but for which God did not seem to have much concern (Ps 6:5: Is 38: 17-19). But Apocalyptic literature, such as today's first reading, gave a new understanding of the meaning of death to the believer. God would rescue at least some from death. "Many of those who sleep in the dust of the earth shall awake, some to everlasting life, and some to shame and everlasting contempt" (Dan 12:2). By the power of God, a totally new existence will come to be; God will triumph over death. Hope in the resurrection of the dead emerged. Wisdom literature gave an even brighter picture of human immortality. "But the souls of the righteous are in the hands of God, and no torment will ever touch them. In the eyes of the foolish they seemed to have died...but they are a peace" (Wis 3:1-4)
