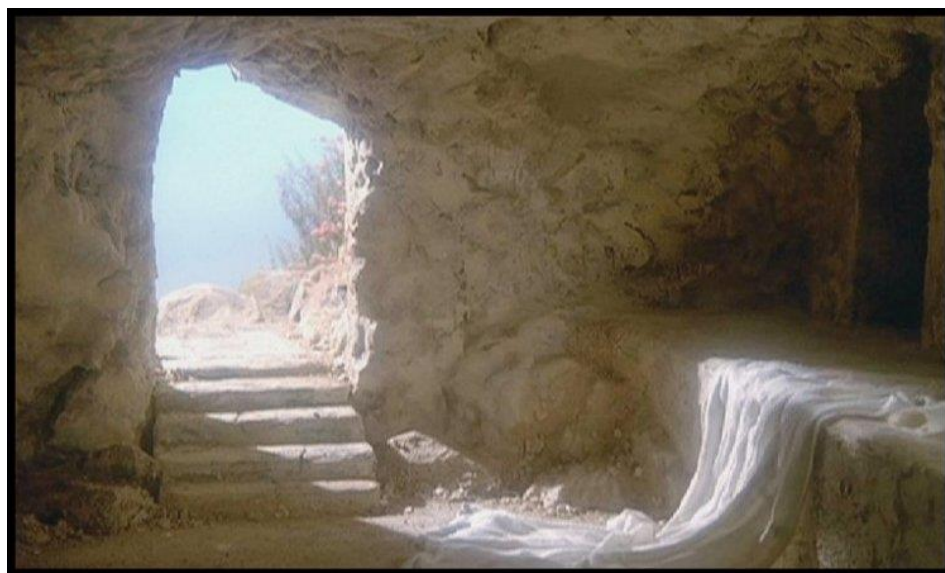

**BUILDING SECURITY**

Representatives of Sacred Heart Parish were recently part of a group of over 300 people who attended a training focusing on safety and security in churches sponsored by the Sheriff's Office and the CRCF. Many ideas were generated, and some have already been implemented. One result that you should be aware of is that once Mass in Lakewood begins on the weekends, the side door of the building will be locked. ***This means that the only way into the building once Mass has started will be through the main entrance.*** We are sorry for any inconvenience this may cause, but the safety of our parishioners and security of our building must be our primary concern.
