EASTER TRIDUUM

The three most sacred days of the liturgical year are known as the Easter Triduum. We recall Jesus' Last Supper with his disciples on *Holy Thursday*; His crucifixion and death on *Good Friday*; and His resurrection on the *Easter Vigil and Easter Day*. After that, in the 50 days of the Easter season, we bask in the joy of Christ's resurrection and the promise given of a new life with God forever.

PONTIFICAL GOOD FRIDAY COLLECTION

Pope Francis has asked for our support of the Pontifical Good Friday Collection, which helps Christians in the Holy Land. Your support helps the Church minister in parishes, provide Catholic schools, offer religious education, preserve the sacred shrines, and provide humanitarian aid to refugees from the wars, unrest, and instability that have been especially hard on Christians. BLESSING OF FOOD

There will be a Blessing of the Food at our church in Lakewood on Saturday, April 20, at 1:00pm. In this Eastern European tradition, baskets containing a sampling of Easter foods are brought to church to be blessed on Holy Saturday. Please join us for this meaningful blessing of the food that will be shared at Easter dinner.

DIVINE MERCY SUNDAY

April 28 is Divine Mercy Sunday. You are invited to join us that day at our church in Panama for special Divine Mercy devotions, including the Divine Mercy Chaplet and blessing of the new Divine Mercy painting that was donated in memory of Mary and George Tichy by their daughters. The devotions will start at 3:00pm and will be followed by a light reception in the church hall. All are welcome to attend.
