Are you registered at Sacred Heart? Occasionally a letter of recommendation to act as a godparent for Baptism or sponsor for Confirmation is needed. In order to get such a letter, you must be a member in good standing of the parish. This means that you not only need to be registered in our parish but also must have received the Sacrament of Confirmation, attend Mass and receive Holy Communion regularly, and contribute to the support of the parish. Additionally, if you are married, the ceremony must have been approved by the Church and your children must attend Catholic school or faith formation classes. If you are a regular parishioner but have not yet registered, please call or stop in at the parish office.
