**Luke 15:1-3, 11-32-4th Sunday of Lent
"Our Father's Infinite Mercy"**

Jesus's actions in today's Gospel manifests God's Mercy-He receives sinners in order to convert them. "Although the word "mercy" does not appear, this parable nevertheless expresses the essence of the divine mercy in a particular way "(Dives in Misericordia 5, Pope John Paul II). In the parable of the prodigal son, Jesus describes the infinite, fatherly mercy of God and his joy at the conversion of a single sinner. So much does God desire the conversion of sinners that this parable ends with great joy over one sinner who repents. "Human Life is in some way a constant returning to our Father's house. We return to our Father's house by means of that sacrament of pardon in which by confessing our sins, we put Jesus Christ again and become his brothers, members of God's family" Christ is passing by 64, St. Jose Escriva).
