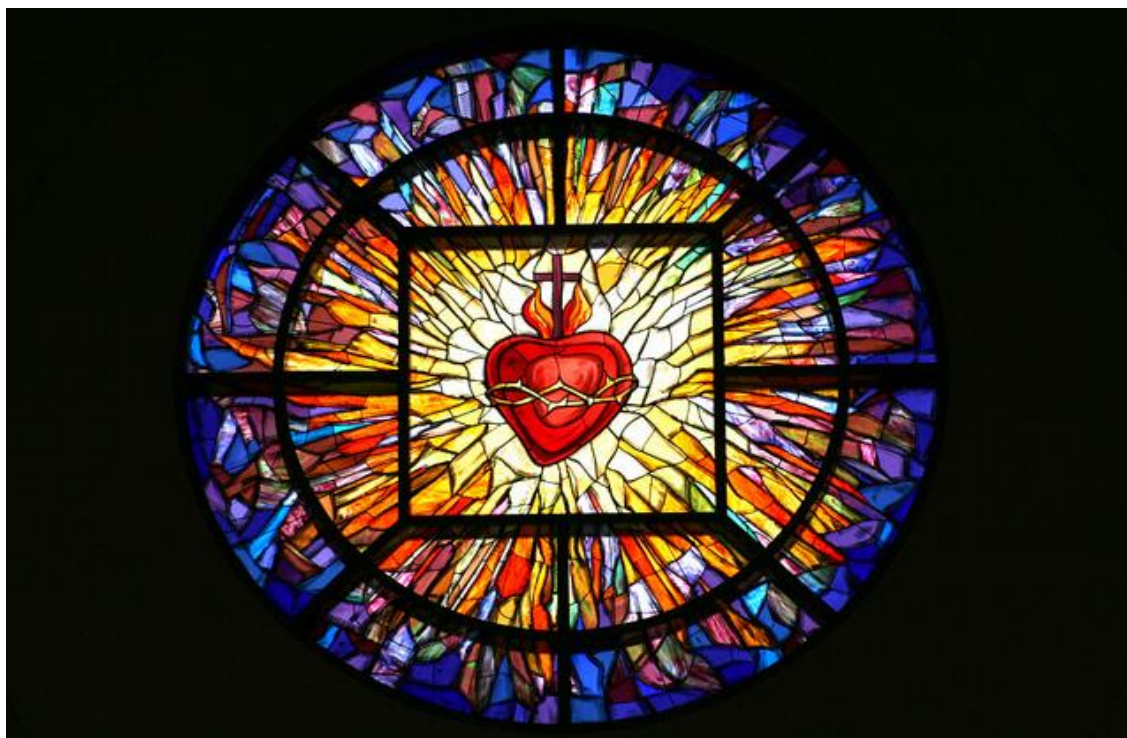

### THE SIGN OF THE CROSS BEFORE THE GOSPEL AT MASS

There is a quick gesture that can often go unnoticed before the recitation of the Gospel reading at Mass. It is a brief tracing of the cross that is not the typical sign of the cross and it is often rather mindlessly made out of habit. This gesture is a direct imitation of what the priest or deacon does before he recites the words of the holy Gospel.

As we make a cross on our forehead, then our lips, and finally on our breast, we are encouraged to interiorly say the following brief prayer that prepares us to receive the Word of God – *May the Word of the Lord be on my mind, on my lips, and in my heart.* What a wonderful prayer to open ourselves to the word of God.
