THE HOLY TRINITY

This Sunday is Trinity Sunday, the central doctrine of the Catholic Church. In the New Testament, there is frequent mention of the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. In speaking of the Trinity, certain effects of God’s actions remind us more of one divine Person than another. Thus, we speak of the Father as the Creator of all that is, that we are His children and He loves us. We speak of the Son as our Savior and Redeemer. And we speak of the Holy Spirit – the love of God poured into our hearts – as our Sanctifier, Who helps us live a sanctifying life.
