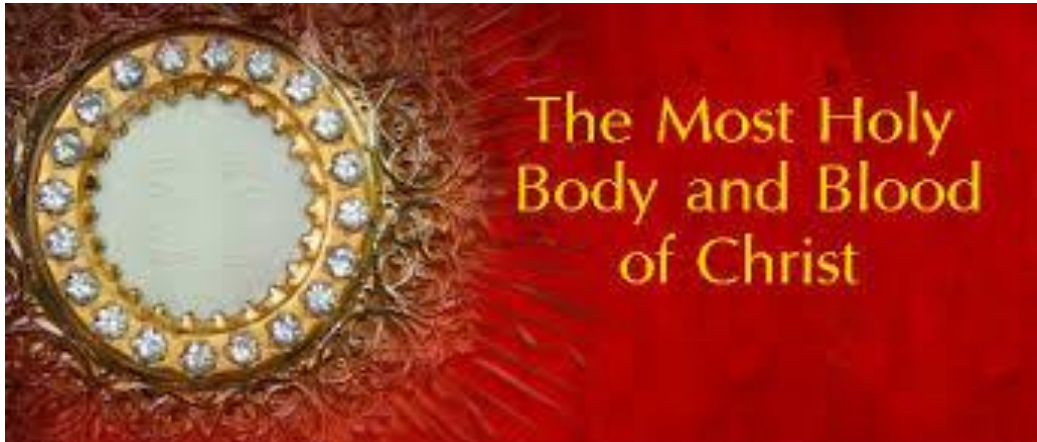

A crucifix helps us to remember that the sacrifice of Christ and the sacrifice of the Eucharist are one single sacrifice. During Mass, Jesus, through the priest, offers himself to the Father for us.
