From the Desk of Fr. Paul

This Saturday we celebrate the Feast Day of Our Lady of Fatima. This widely known apparition of the Blessed Mother to three shepherd children encourages us to pray for peace by praying at the Rosary every day. The three shepherd children, Lucia (10 y.o.), St. Francisco (9 y.o.), St. Jacinta (7 y.o.), received apparitions from the angel of peace in 1916 and then from the Blessed Mother herself on the 13th of every month from May to October of 1917. The angel of peace taught them how to worship God almighty with a profound bow and two beautiful prayers that can be incorporated into our daily morning prayers:

"My God I believe, I adore, I hope, and I love You. I beg pardon for those who do not believe, do not adore, do not hope, and do not love You."

"O most Holy Trinity, Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, I adore You profoundly, I offer You the most precious Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity of Jesus Christ, present in all the tabernacles of the world, in reparation for the outrages, the sacrileges and indifferences by which He is offended. And through the infinite merits of His most Sacred Heart and the Immaculate Heart of Mary I beg of You the conversion of poor sinners."

When Mary appeared to the three children, she also taught them the Fatima prayer to be prayed in between each of the five decades of the Rosary:

"O my Jesus, forgive us our sins, save us from the fires of hell, lead all souls to heaven, especially those in most need of Your mercy."

You can definitely see a theme within all of these prayers as the angel of peace and the Blessed Mother begs us to pray for peace in the world, and to pray for the conversion of our own souls and the souls of others. This is an important reminder to take care that our souls are in the state of grace. This is why it is so important to go to the Sacrament of Confession often so that we can receive Jesus in the Eucharist with clean souls free of mortal sins.

In addition to the shepherd children's love for the Blessed Mother, they also had a strong and deep devotion to the Eucharist. They lovingly called the presence of Christ in the Eucharist as the "Hidden Jesus." St. Francisco was known to spend time before the tabernacle in silent prayer before his "Hidden Jesus" and his love for Jesus grew in this way.

May our love and devotion grow to these two pillars of our faith, the Eucharist, and the Blessed Mother Mary. Take some time during this month dedicated to Mary to pray the Rosary, to grow in grace like the three shepherd children of Fatima and to spend time adoring our Lord truly present in the Holy Eucharist.
