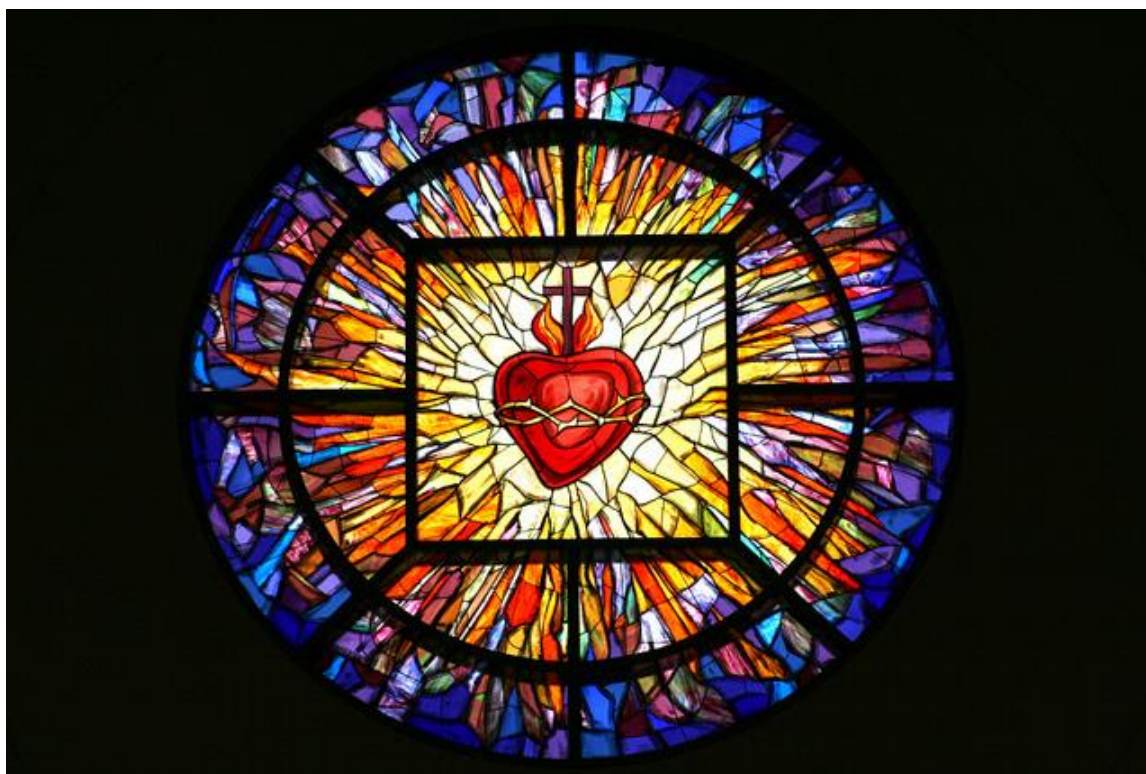

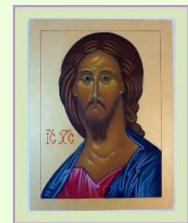
LAKESWOOD CHICKEN BARBECUE
