PILGRIM VIRGIN STATUE TO VISIT ST. MARY OF LOURDES

On Monday, August 27, the National Pilgrim Virgin Statue of Our Lady of Fatima will be on display at St. Mary of Lourdes Parishes in Bemus Point and Mayville.

The National Pilgrim Virgin Statue was blessed by Pope Paul VI in 1967 in honor of the 50th Anniversary of Our Lady's apparitions at Fatima. This statue now travels throughout the United States and its territories, spreading the message of Fatima and bringing the graces of Fatima to the American people. It is considered one of the most beautiful statues in the world.

The request of Our Lady of Fatima for prayer and sacrifice is for reparation for sin and the conversion of sinners. Bill Sockey, the custodian who now travels the U.S. with the statue, will carry the message of Fatima, which was delivered to the world through three shepherd children in Portugal in 1917.

Don't miss out on this beautiful event. Listen and learn the Message of Our Lady of Fatima. The statue will be on display in Mayville for Mass and Veneration from 8:00-10:30am, and then it will be moved to the Bemus Point church where Veneration will take place a 1:00pm, and the Rosary prayed at 6:00pm, followed by the custodian's talk on the Message of Fatima, which is as relevant today as it was in 1917.
