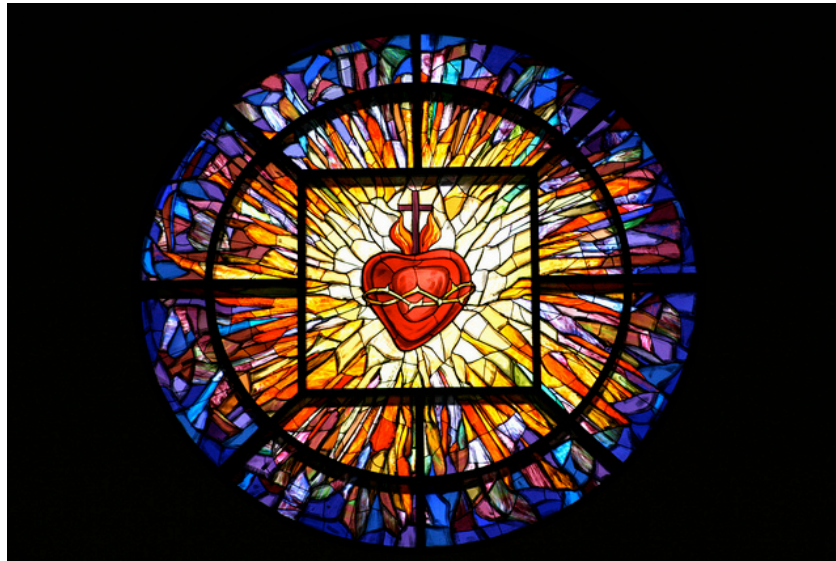

THE SIGN OF THE CROSS

Why do Catholics make the sign of the cross?

The sign of the cross has been used since the earliest days of Christianity. We find it in the writings from the Fathers of the Church as early as the second century.

It is more than a rote gesture or superstition. The sign of the cross is used throughout the Liturgy and Sacraments. It is, at its essence, a blessing. When we enter the church, we bless ourselves by making the sign of the cross with holy water, and we always begin and end our prayers with it. So, even if you’ve been making the sign of the cross all your life, don’t ever let it lose its meaning. Receive your blessing! In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit!
