

From the desk of Fr. Paul

We have such a wealth of prayers, litanies, novenas, and spiritual practices within our Catholic faith. There is a saint dedicated to every cause and petition. Since the early church, faithful Christians were praying for the intersession of the Blessed Mother. A prayer to the Blessed Mother called the Sub Tuum Praesidium (Under Your Protection) can be dated all the way back to AD 200. The prayer is as follows:

We fly to thy protection,

O holy Mother of God,

Despise not our petitions in our necessities,

But deliver us always from dangers,

O glorious and blessed Virgin,

Amen

It is a simple, yet profound prayer. It also points to the fact that since the beginning of the Church, the Blessed Mother was honored in a special way. This prayer may seem familiar to you because very similar language is used in the well-known Memorare prayer. The Memorare prayer was created in the $15^{\rm th}$ century and expresses how we can turn to the Blessed Mother for protection and for help. This Prayers is as follows.

Remember O Most Gracious Virgin Mary,

That never was it known that anyone who fled to thy protection, Implored thy help, or sought thy intercession was left unaided,

Inspired by this confidence I fly unto thee,

O Virgin of virgins, my mother,

To thee do I come, before thee I stand,

Sinful and sorrowful,

O Mother of the Word Incarnate, despise not my petitions,

But in thy mercy hear and answer me.

Amen.

This prayer is useful in any circumstance. If you are starting a road trip, if you don't have enough time to pray a full Rosary, but you would still like to invoke the help of the Blessed mother or if you just want to pray for Mary's intercession. And we know that when we turn to the Blessed Mother with any petition that we may have we can do so with confidence because she brings our petition to the throne of her Son, Jesus. And how can Jesus refuse his own mother?

Blessed Mother Pray for us!
