Our Lord Jesus Christ King of the Universe

On the last Sunday of each liturgical year, the Church celebrates the Solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe, or Christ the King. Pope Pius XI instituted this feast in 1925 with his encyclical *Quas primas* ("In the first") to respond to growing secularism and atheism. He recognized that attempting to "thrust Jesus Christ and his holy law" out of public life would result in continuing discord among people and nations. **This solemnity reminds us that while governments come and go, Christ reigns as King forever!**

FROM THE PASTOR

John 18:33-37 – 34th Sunday Ordinary Time (Feast of Christ the King)

Jesus Christ came into this world "to testify to the truth" (Jn18:37). We are called to do no less. Lying is wrong, it is the most direct offense, and it is forbidden by the Eight Commandment (Exod 20:16; Duet 5:20). Jesus denounced lying as the work of the devil: "You are of your father the devil...there is no truth in him. When he lies, he speaks according to his own nature, for he is a liar and the father of lies" (Jn *;44; CCC2482) Lying is communication of information that is contrary to what is in one's mind. St. Paul wrote: "Do not lie to one another" for you "have stripped off the old self with its practices and have clothed yourself with the new self..." (Col3:9-10). Again St. Paul wrote: "So then, putting away falsehood, let all of us speak the truth to our neighbors" (eph 4:24-25). To lie is to speak or act against the truth in order to lead someone into error (ccc2483). In all situations, Christians must strive to be trustworthy and honest.
