Advent

We all know that Advent can be a busy time as we prepare for Christmas! Every year we say we are going to slow down and take time to enjoy all those preparations but wind up being exhausted before Christmas even arrives. If anything, this year we know how precious time can be. Even if we make one positive change this Advent, it will be an Advent well spent. First and foremost, we should pray to God to help us recognize the “Reason for the Season”. We need to slow down to hear Him speak to us. This is just a small sample of things we can implement into our lives during Advent.

1. Take a walk: Take 10-15 Minutes in nature to slow us down and tune into the rhythm of the natural world.
2. Have a cup of tea or coffee: and do nothing during the time it takes to finish. No phones. No tv. No working. Just sit for 5 minutes.
3. Read the Gospel of the day twice and choose a word phrase that jumps out at you. This is basically lectio Divina an ancient monastic form of prayer.
4. Set aside one night per week as “No Technology Night” Read a book, write a letter, but don’t use technology! Order a pizza, play a game, engage with those you love without screens getting in the way.
