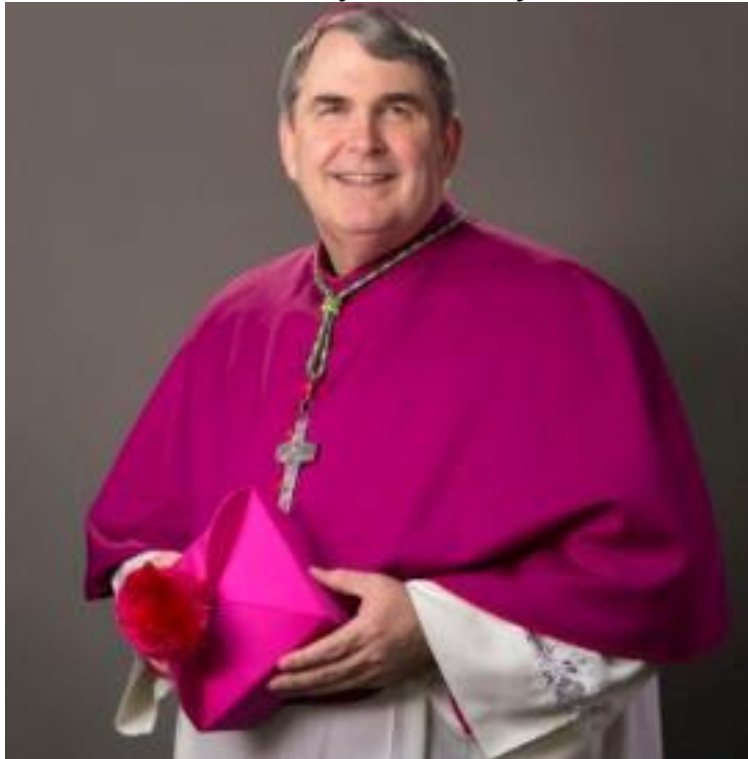

**A LETTER FROM OUR PASTOR**

We welcome our new Bishop, Most Rev. Michael Fisher! This special moment in the history of the Diocese of Buffalo affords a family the opportunity to participate in celebrating the arrival of a new Bishop. Remembering that the family is the domestic church and the foundation of all understanding of what it means to be Church, the following are a few suggestions for families to celebrate their faith and their identity as the domestic Church.

1. Remember the special moments of people arriving to become part of your family – new births, special visits by in-laws. Talk about the preparation for these arrivals. What changes took place in the family because of these arrivals? What preparations has the diocese done to welcome the new Bishop to its family? Talk about how your family will welcome the new bishop i.e. follow the media coverage, post a welcome message on the diocesan website ([buffalodiocese.org](http://buffalodiocese.org)).
2. Share the family faith story. Talk about the importance of your Catholic faith to your family's life. Share the story of the diocesan faith story by researching the history of your parish or of the diocese.
3. Visit the Cathedral of St. Joseph in Buffalo.
4. As a family, write a welcome letter to the new bishop. Smaller children could draw a picture of their family and send it to Bishop Fisher.
5. Discuss the meaning of the diocesan coat of arms (on the website [buffalodiocese.org](http://buffalodiocese.org)). As a family, create your own family coat of arms. Designate a family motto.
6. Each night at the family meal, pray for the new Bishop.
