#### Luke 11:1-13 17th Sunday Ordinary Time "Vocal Prayer"

Jesus gave His disciples the Our Father, the greatest vocal prayer of Christianity, as a model for prayer. Vocal prayer is any form of prayer expressed in words, whether printed or spoken, silent or vocalized. Traditionally there are four types of vocal prayer: adoration, petition, thanksgiving, and contrition. The prayer of adoration is an act of submission to God, acknowledging we are His creatures, and it is our duty to praise and worship Him. With the prayer of petition, we ask God to provide temporal or spiritual assistance. The prayer of thanksgiving is the expression of gratitude by which we give thanks to God for favors we have received. Finally, the prayer of contrition asks God's forgiveness for our sins and imperfections. With our busy lives prayer need not be long and complicated. The Psalms are a great source of prayers suited to the needs sand moods of every person.
