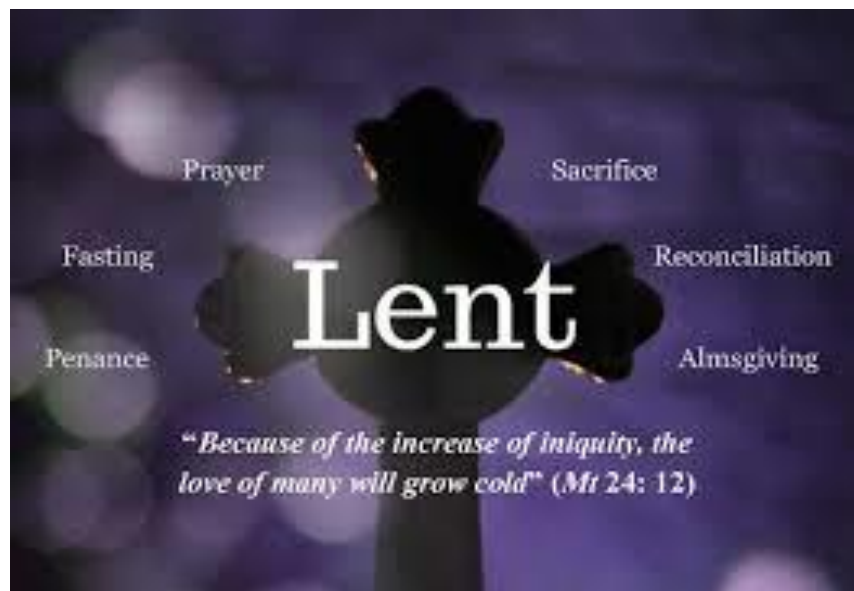

*In re The Diocese of Buffalo N.Y.*  
Case No. 20-10322

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE THAT, On February 28, 2020, The Diocese of Buffalo N.Y., ("Diocese") filed for protection under chapter 11 of title 11 of the United States Code (the "Bankruptcy Code").

The Bankruptcy Court has established August 14, 2021 at 11:59 p.m. (prevailing Eastern time) as the deadline to file proofs of claim against the Diocese (the "Bar Date").

If you have a claim against the Diocese, including, without limitation, a claim related to sexual abuse committed by any person connected with the Diocese, you must file a claim on or before the Bar Date.

FROM THE PASTOR

Exodus 20:1-17- 3<sup>rd</sup> Sunday in Lent  
"Ten Commandments"

In today's first reading from Exodus we hear the Ten Commandments. "The gift of the commandments is the gift of God himself and his holy will" (CCC2059). Some see the Ten Commandments as too confining and too restrictive, too difficult. Others view them as merely the Ten Suggestions. These people are wrong. Jesus stressed their importance to the rich young man: "If you would enter into life, keep the commandments" (Mt 19:16-17). The Ten Commandments are an explicit statement of the natural laws of truth, order and justice and they are unchangeable because God made them for all time. Just as following a road map will get you to your vacation destination, by following the Ten Commandments you will arrive safely at your eternal destination. Finally if we are firmly devoted to God we will follow the advice of Jesus gave us: "If you love Me, keep My commandments" (Jn 14:15).

Our First Reconciliation students are learning the Ten Commandments! Do you remember them? If you don't know them, you cannot put them into practice in your life! Join our students with your family at home and memorize those commandments, talk about them, and practice them in your day to day life!

Ten Commandments

1. I am the Lord your God, thou shall not have any strange Gods before me.
2. Thou shalt not take the name of the Lord thy God in vain.
3. Remember to keep holy the Sabbath Day
4. Honor thy Father and Mother
5. Thou shalt not kill
6. Thou shalt not commit adultery.
7. Thou shalt not steal
8. Thou shalt not bear false witness.
9. Thou shalt not covet they neighbors wife.
10. Thou shalt not covet they neighbors goods
