

From the Desk of Fr. Paul

We are quickly approaching the holiest three days of the year, Holy Thursday, Good Friday and Holy Saturday, the Triduum. Every year we enter these three days as a solemn way to participate in Jesus' paschal mystery, His passion, death, and resurrection. We reflect on the sublime mysteries of how Jesus offered everything of Himself for our salvation out of pure love for us.

The Jesuit practice of imaginative prayer can be very helpful for us during this holy time. At different times during the Triduum, place yourself at the gates of Jerusalem waving palm branches before the son of David, hoping for the salvation of humankind. Place yourself at the Last Supper beside Jesus as He celebrates the very first Eucharist. Place yourself in the Garden of Gethsemane where Jesus sweat drops of blood and He accepted the cup of suffering out of loving obedience to the Father's will. Place yourself in Simon Peter's shoes as he denies Jesus three times when Jesus is being led before the Sanhedrin. Place yourself on the way of the Cross and imagine Mary meeting Jesus, Veronica wiping the face of Jesus, Simon of Cyrene helping Jesus carry His Cross or Jesus meeting the mourning women of Jerusalem. Place yourself at the foot of the Cross and in utmost humility lay down your sins before the Lord thanking God for His sacrifice on the Cross. Place yourself at the tomb of Christ as the stone rolls shut and the sacrifice of God becomes all the more real.

Enter into the Paschal Mystery, the reality of our salvation. This is more than a story; this is God's plan in action and is real today as it was 2000 years ago. May God bless you and your family abundantly as we reflect together on these sublime mysteries. And please join us in all of our various parishes where we will as a whole family of parishes celebrate God's action in us.
