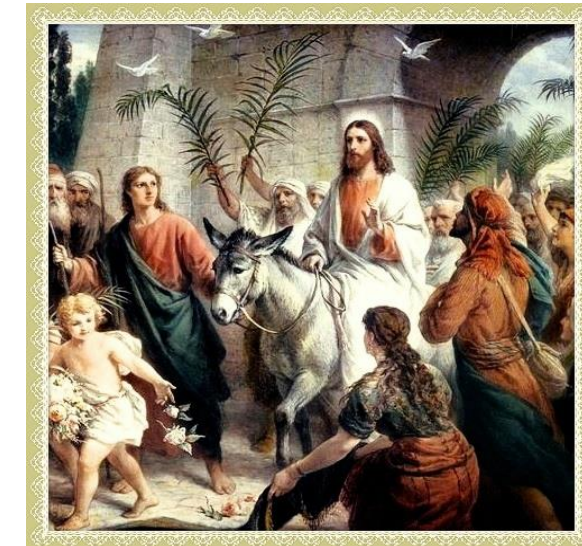

FROM THE PASTOR

Luke 22:14-23, 56-Palm Sunday  
"The Real Presence"

Very early in Church history the Church Fathers were unanimous- Jesus is truly present, body, blood, soul, and divinity in the Eucharist. How could anyone, after more than 1,500 years, doubt this belief or questions those Church Fathers, but that's what happened following the Protestant Reformation. St. Ignatius was taught by the apostle St. John who walked with Jesus for three years. St. Ignatius wrote: "I have no taste for corruptible food...I desire the bread of God which is the **flesh of Jesus Christ...and for drink I desire his blood...**" (Letter to the Romans) 7:3110AD). In Homilies on Numbers 7:2(248AD) Origen wrote ". now however, in full view, there is true food, the **flesh** of the Word of God, as he himself says: "My **flesh is true food**, and my **blood** is true drink" And St. Cyril in 350 AD wrote "...The invocation having been made, the bread becomes the **body** of Christ and the wine the **blood** of Christ" (Catechetical Lectures )19:7
