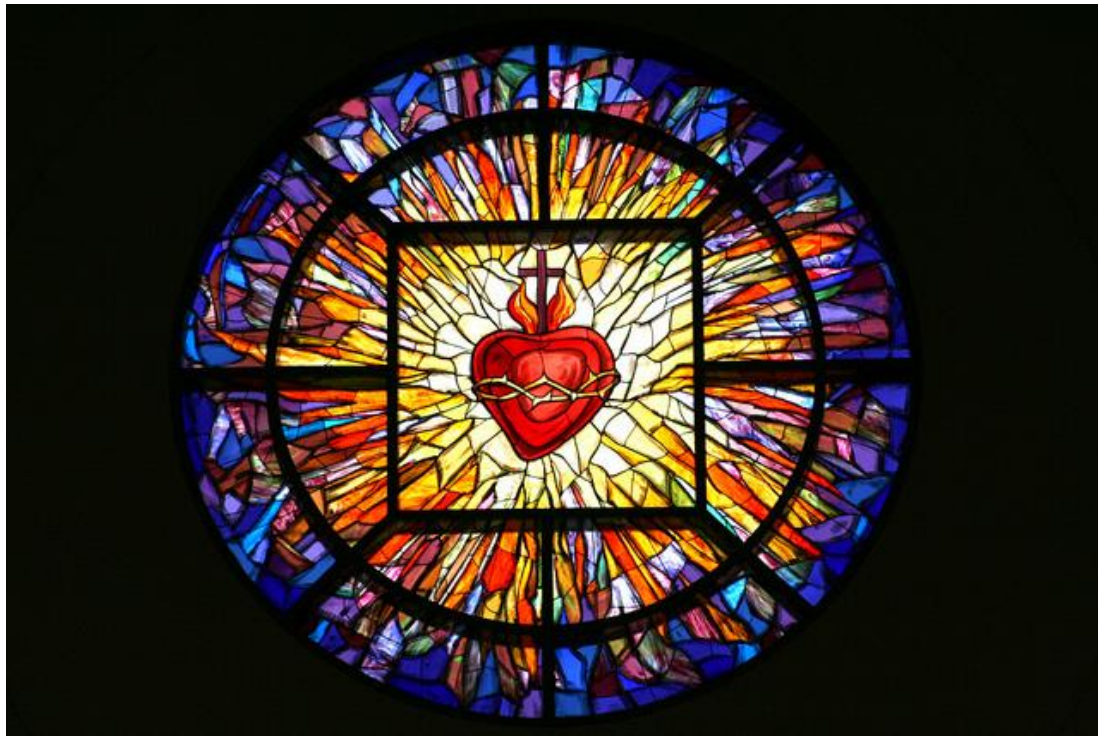

Faith Formation News

Our Faith Formation year ended very suddenly without a chance to say goodbye or to explain to the kids face to face why we were ending classes. We know it has been a very difficult times for families to adjust to our new normal.

Since the end of May our focus has been on setting guidelines in place for reopening the church. We were blessed to be able to have an outdoor Mass on June 21 with the help of volunteers. The following week we spent preparing the church for public Masses. It was a productive week but stressful. Our first priority is the safety of our parishioners as you come to worship.

During PAUSE Faith Formation materials were sent home for parents to continue instruction at home. We are getting closer to September and are awaiting guidelines for forming our classes for the year. We are taking a wait and see attitude when it comes to classes this year. We want to give parents a chance to get into a routine with the regular school schedule. We believe that we should have some kind of answer as to how we will proceed by the end of the month.

We know that Covid-19 has thrown our worlds a bit upside down. The dispensation for Sunday Mass is still in effect at this time. You are welcome to continue with Mass online. However, we do invite you back to public Masses at Sacred Heart. We do have guidelines that have to be followed. We know it can be a little overwhelming the first time back to Mass. So if you have any questions, please feel free to call the parish office. Remember you can also come to a weekday Mass with your families. It does not have to be on a Sunday while the dispensation is still in place. Our weekday Mass have fewer people. If you have little ones and would like to come into the church and show them around before you attend your first Mass since PAUSE, please give us a call. We can arrange a time for you to come. However you choose to worship during this time is your choice.

On a happy note we celebrated two First Holy Communions. Kelly Dollard and Zacharey Muniz received the Eucharist for the very first time in May with their families in attendance.
